Mentor Corner

Beyond The Classroom - The Reggio Way

"It has been said that the environment should act as a kind aquarium which reflects the ideas, ethics, attitudes and life-style of the people who live in it." Lorris Malaguzzi

One of the strongest message we have imbibed from Reggio Emilia, is the important role the environment plays in the life and education of the child.

At Vivero, the outdoor classroom is an extension of our indoor space. Our teachers ensure our environments are interesting, educational and full of discovery. We truly believe that when children are engaged in their learning, they are better able to make connections, retain information, and become critical thinkers.

Our teachers ensure our environments are interesting, educational and full of discovery by following a few design characteristics:

- Light, Shadow and Reflection: To facilitate investigation of the interplay of light and shadows, we ensure that both natural and artificial light sources are used in the environment. Reflective surfaces are also used to provoke the investigation of reflection.
- *Transparency:* At Vivero, we have maintained transparency within the environment to allow visibility and linking of internal spaces. This also encourages the sense of community.
- *Materials*: We always strive to provide a wide range of resources, including natural and recycled materials, which have enormous creative possibilities and encourage children to inquire, explore, investigate and discover.
- Flexibility of space: Our indoor and outdoor spaces are designed to be flexible, with
 the objective of providing best support to children and learning engagements.
 Spaces can be arranged or adapted to support both large as well small groups,
 including spaces for individuals who choose to work on their own.



Our ideas about the spaces in our schools have evolved and been influenced in different ways by educators such as Lev Vygotsky and Loris Malaguzzi. From child-sized furnishings, to the creation of social spaces for language development, and the introduction of puppets, light and shadow for storytelling. These details, when integrated with the curriculum, have resulted in spaces that attend to social interaction, problem solving, dramatic play, storytelling, fantasy, conflict and its resolution, and communication for children to build their skills and further their understanding of the world.





Training the Mentors

At the beginning of yet another academic year, we geared up for the Academic Teacher Training Programme. In line with our promise of attracting, developing and retaining passionate and capable educators committed to continuous improvement in their learners and themselves, this year, we integrated many new initiatives in our curriculum. To ensure that our teachers fulfill every individual learner's potential, positively contributing to their academic and overall growth, our Pedagogy team developed a more comprehensive module. This module focuses on new initiatives, educator's role as a facilitator and researcher, creating stimulating environment and transitioning from one activity to the other.

At Vivero, we also conduct regular workshops and training sessions by industry experts. Each year, our teachers and the entire team at school undergo an extensive First- Aid certification training. The trainers discuss and demonstrate First- aid techniques for the team to understand and execute in case of an emergency. They are also trained in handling other basic injuries such as cuts, wounds, sprains and burns. This session covers all essential first-aid aspects thus enabling our team to administer basic aid in case of an emergency.



Separation Anxiety



10 tips for managing separation anxiety:

- 1. De-Stress Your Morning Routine: Sleep early and be prepared for the morning routines. This helps to build less anxiety before school!
- 2. Pack a piece of home: If your child has a comfort item like a blanket, a family photo or a soft toy, pack it in their backpack so they'll have a bit of familiarity if they get homesick.
- 3. Show they are safe: Before starting a new routine show your child it is a safe place to be, by spending some time with them there. Do a dry run, find out if you can visit the classroom with your child the week before school starts. Show them where you'll be doing drop-off, where their room will be, and let them walk around to get familiar with the space.
- **4.** Practice makes perfect: If this is the first time your child will be away from you, do some practice separation. Arrange for her to spend a few hours at a grandparent or friend's house, and gradually build up to a whole day away.
- 5. Find some friendly faces: See if you can find one or two other children who will be in your child's class, set up a playdate before school starts. It'll give you a chance to get to know some fellow parents and help acclimate your child to their new friends.
- **6.** Create routines: Try to do the same drop-off with the same ritual at the same time each day you separate to avoid unexpected factors whenever you can.
- 7. Be quick in goodbyes: Keeping your goodbye short and sweet limits the transition time and level of anxiety.
- **8.** Keep your promises: Return to pick them at the time promised. By keeping your promises you will build trust and independence.
- 9. Be specific: Your child may not understand when you say you'll be back to pick them up at 3pm, so use terms they can understand. Saying things such as, "I'll be back once you've had a nap and some snack" is something they can relate to.
- 10. Watch yourself: It's not just children that suffer separation anxiety, with many parents also hating being away from their child. It's okay to feel concerned for your child when you're away from them but showing that concern on your face or through your body language can cause distress for your child.


