

Integrating technology in the curriculum within a classroom set up facilitates peer collaboration. Cubetto - a toy robot which moves over a mat filled with coloured blocks attracts and engages all as it teaches precoding and computer programming skills specially designed for young children. Vivero teachers added their own special touch by placing cutouts of pirate ships on the Cubetto Mat to give the children the opportunity to also navigate through a course and get to their chosen destination along with Cubetto. The children took this fun adventure-learning-sequence a notch higher by wearing pirate hats and wielding their own fancy swords to pose as the pirates for the day. The pumping background music added to the sense of adventure and excitement throughout. It was a great way to challenge their directional skills and the children were fascinated to see how the robot moved with the push of a few buttons!

"Vivero International is committed to shaping responsible, global citizens and passionate lifelong learners who are prepared for the 21st century" and this shining purpose is driven majorly by another set of lifelong learners our Facilitators. Teachers at Vivero are more than just their title. They passionately don the multi-roles of a mentor, guide and philosopher for the children. Therefore to keep our Facilitators abreast with the latest research on pedagogy and to equip them with more interesting ideas to share further, we hold regular refresher workshops. Our unique curriculum is consistently aligned to complement the latest research on pedagogy and principles of early years education. It is of paramount importance that we prepare ourselves first in order to provide a holistic learning environment for our learners.

A Refresher's Teachers training program was organized for the teachers and support staff at Vivero International, Powai in November this year. A senior curriculum team member from our Corporate Team along with the

Vice Principal and School Head conducted a two-day rigorous training program based on the importance of enriching board displays, storytelling and setting up provocative environments conducive for learning and development. Also for the first time, an online training program was conducted by a Senior member of the Tech Integration team. where she trained our teachers on the appropriate variety of ways on how the new robot 'DASH' could be used at school .

The faculty from our Pre School & Child Care centres at Pune gathered for the annual refresher in the second week of November 2018. The 'Refresher Training' was centered on the themes of provocation, board documentation and storytelling.

The first theme began with a room set up with newspapers, fashion magazines, glue, scissors, measuring tape & sewing accessories. Teachers worked in groups as they wondered, discovered and created designs. Overall it was an experiential learning session about how to provide the right amount of provocation in order to make children voluntarily inquire, think and learn, thus setting the mood for an exciting Unit 3.

Children take great pride in their work and this is a fun way to make them reflect on their learnings too. Documentation and display therefore becomes another natural learning tool for children. A healthy dose of brainstorming was the course of action for the next training session where teachers focused on untapped areas of the school & classrooms which could possibly be used for more stimulating documentation and display of children's work.

An interesting module on storytelling was also discussed to enable teachers to conduct more effective book-reading sessions. Teachers were given new ideas on how to read stories to children, what to choose in order to connect better with children and the impact of voice modulation. Tips were shared on how to handle little distractions and make the activity even more memorable and fun.

Every training module at Vivero is thoughtfully constructed. The singular focus is to make the learning experience for the teacher more enriching and to ensure that they are empowered as effective facilitators in the premise of our 21st Century Learners.

The workshop for our pre-schools in Bangalore took place in the last week before the Winter Holidays. This 2 Day Refresher Training included exciting topics for the teachers which gave them new ideas to spruce up their facilitating canvas.
















Hawaiian Carnival

Safety at Vivero International

It is the right of every child to grow unhesitatingly and un-haltingly in a safe and secure environment. At Vivero Pre-Schools and Childcare centres, we ensure that every staff member is sensitized to make the environment absolutely safe in all aspects for the children. Physical and Emotional safety is the non-negotiable requirements from every Facilitator, Care Taker or Support Staff. Only when the child feels completely secure will he or she be ready to learn and develop further. Much thought is given to even the most minute details when setting up the learning spaces for our young children.

- · Handrails and Sanitary Appliances are fitted keeping in mind the general height and size of a pre-schooler
- Electric sockets, door corners and sharp edges are discreetly child-proofed
- The entire premise is under 24 hour CCTV surveillance
- A right of entry and exit is reserved for all visitors and a stringent arrival/dispersal mechanism is in place for the children too
- Daily temperature check and hand sanitization is a part of the arrival ritual
- Every personnel is selected with thorough background checks and various levels of interaction. Rigorous onboarding and regular refresher training programs
 are a part of every recruitment process
- We maintain a simple yet strict guideline for Food & Nutrition. Our in-house kitchen functions under set hygiene standards only
- Emergency evacuation and Fire Safety drills are introduced to our young learners via interactive demonstrations
- · Bright and Stimulating learning spaces along with clean and calm napping areas ensure that children feel at ease at all times
- Daily Quality Checks ensure cleanliness and hygiene upkeep of the campus. Bi-Annual Quality Audits ascertain the degree at which the processes are being followed or if any gaps are to be plugged
- The schools are equipped with clear Standard Operating Procedures that leave no room for ambiguity




