POCSO Training

The POCSO training encourages teachers to foster an atmosphere where children feel comfortable expressing themselves. By conducting the POCSO training, the school demonstrates its commitment in maintaining the highest standards of child protection, and fostering trust between the school and the parent. Vivero stands steadfast in its commitment to create a safe and secure learning environment for all communities at school.

Incorporating hands-on engagements, classroom scenarios and case studies enabled our teachers to think and apply their knowledge to problem solve during their regular working at school. In summary, teacher training is essential for creating a positive and effective learning environment that supports the holistic development of young children. Our aim is to boost teacher morale, which ultimately improves student outcomes thereby reiterating the school's commitment to continuous professional development and growth.











Mid-Year Refresher Training for Teachers - Pune

The Vivero, Pune teachers had a refresher training on provocation and classroom management. As we moved to our third unit of enquiry teachers had to encourage "rigour" with children exhibiting readiness. The right kind of provocations make it easier for children to understand concepts in math and language. Teachers were given a fun provocation as the outcome was designing a Christmas party outfit. They used paper to create the outfit and accessorised it using Christmas colours. They clearly understood the impact of the provocation as the outcome was to their liking!

Teachers constantly look for strategies in classroom management. We discussed various situations in classrooms to understand the psyche of children and find solutions for the same. It was very fruitful as all the teachers actively participated to gain insight into various classroom management strategies.

We also discussed the importance of having a writing table in the classroom to give children an opportunity to explore various writing tools. Teachers brainstormed various things like stencils, small writing pads, "story" books, letter cards and word cards that could be added to a writing table. Pre Nursery and Nursery could include playdough and zip lock bags with paint along with stamp pads and stamps to their table. The teachers are excited to carry forward their learning into their classrooms and soon the writing tables will be part of every classroom.





POSH Training

Pre Nursery and Nursery children made crafts related to the 'Tiranga' and danced on patriotic songs which awakened everyone's feelings towards the Mother Land.



It was truly a delight to see that no matter where life takes us, we always carry a piece of Vivero in our hears!


















Ganesh Chaturthi


This not only delighted the taste buds but also provided an opportunity for everyone to experience the flavours of various cultures.
