#### The Green School

At Vivero we commenced our Green School initiative in the current academic year. This will help cultivate environmental consciousness and social responsibility in our children at an early age. By integrating this initiative with their learning journey, we aspire to equip our children with the skills and mind set needed to actively participate in environmental conservation.

Green School Projects move beyond theories and textbooks and concentrates solely on 'doing'. With an objective to sensitise our K1 & K2 children towards the environment we plan to have meaningful and hands-on thought provoking engagements.

We are introducing the various facets of sustainability and creating awareness about the environment we live in by touching upon areas like-pollution, water, and electricity wastage and more. To initiate the discussion our K1 & K2 teachers along with the children brain stormed about the various steps they would like to take to ensure we are using energy resources efficiently, being mindful about waste segregation, saving water, etc. Both classes are collaborating to create a vibrant herbal and flower garden on campus, symbolizing their commitment to nurturing nature and maintaining a cleaner, greener environment.

To begin with our K1 & K2 children learned about waste segregation by sorting kitchen waste into wet (like peels) and dry (like plastic). This helped them see how wet waste can be composted, while dry waste harms the environment. To deepen their understanding of sustainability, a field trip to Kasa Rasa was organized. During the visit, students participated in a hands-on session about waste management, learning how trash is collected, sorted, and segregated. This experience empowered them to not only implement these practices at school but also spread awareness within their communities, turning their learning into action. We all pledged to protect our planet and adopt these habits daily.


## Literacy Week






